The Revival Fellowship has been hosting Easter Camp at the CYC "Campialba" in Hervey Bay, Queensland for the last 10 years.

If you've never been to one of our Easter Camps before - you should - Camp has a great family atmosphere and as anyone who has been to a Campialba camp will tell you- no one goes home hungry. The cost includes accommodation, all meals and you won't even need to pick up a tea-towel.

You get to enjoy fun and uplifting fellowship with saints from around Australia. It's not remotely busy and there is heaps of FREE time just to relax and unwind. Hervey Bay is located approx. 3 ½ hours north of Brisbane or 1 ½ hours south of Bundaberg.

Campialba camp can cater for up to 140 people with the facility to accommodate 110 on site.

There are also 6 powered camp sites available

If you would prefer not to share a Cabin, you also have the option of staying at "Comfort Inn on Main Hervey Bay" in one of their queen room's.

Due to limited spaces and the high amount of interest, to avoid disappointment remember to register online as soon as possible.

Registrations

To register simply click on "Register Here" on the top of the Hervey Bay Easter camp website and fill out the online camp form.

Payment

Once you register, you will be issued an invoice within 48 hours detailing the camp fees owing.

Remember a minimum \$100 deposit is required against your invoice to finalise your registration and secure your place at camp. After paying the deposit you have the option of making part payments to spread the camp fees over a number of weeks until camp starts.

Alternatively, if you wish to make one easy payment and pay your camp fees in full you have this option also.

To make things easier for when you arrive at camp for check-in we do ask if you can pay your invoice in full before you arrive.

Please contact us if there are any problems so other arrangements can be made.

Accommodation

Cabins - Accommodation is provided in the form of 12 eight-person "Cabins" with bunk-beds, two bedrooms with one queen size bed and one single bed, and three bedrooms with queen size beds which are serviced by an ensuite suitable for disabled persons. There are wall-mounted oscillating fans in most rooms plus plenty of windows. The wooden floors and verandahs add to the charm of the facilities. Please be aware you may be sharing a cabin with other people. We will do our best to accommodate everyone's needs with all sleeping arrangements and keep families together.

Caravan Site - There is also available 6 onsite power sites to bring our caravan.

Comfort Inn on Main Hervey Bay - These Queen or Family Rooms are offsite and are within 3 minutes walking distance to camp. Room size from 34 m² air-conditioning, tea and coffee making facilities and all with private bathroom

Amenities

There is a male and a female toilet block, featuring five shower cubicles each, plus sinks, mirrors and toilets. Toilets are also provided on the verandahs convenient to the cabins.

Dining Room

As anyone who has been to a Campialba camp will tell you- no one goes home hungry. The dining room seems to be the heart of Campialba. It's where the meals are served and people catch up for a chat. Self-serve tea and coffee making facilities are available at any time of day. The dining room is attached to the full catering kitchen, including an industrial dishwasher so you won't even need to pick up a tea-towel.

Assembly Hall (the upstairs bit)

Above the dining room is the assembly hall which this year is going to be set up as a kid's zone and where Sunday school will be held. Lots of Crafts, Movie Night, Games and fun things for the young ones to do over camp

Recreational Hall (the 'Rec Hall')

This space is where all of our meetings are being held over camp. This structure, with its high ceiling and large floor plan and has plenty of room for seating. It is fully ready for any items, skits and choruses you wish to perform. It's also all on ground level so no need to walk up any stairs this year and has its own toilets.

The Oval, Trampolines and Volley Court

A large grassed oval is the ideal place for outdoor activities like touch football or soccer. Campialba holds one of the last "old school" style Olympic trampolines that has plenty of bounce left in it. A full sand volleyball court located at one end of the oval another sporting option (or sandpit for the young'uns when not in use).

Pool Room and Playground

For those wanting to go "straight to the pool room", they'll find two pool tables, a piano and lounges to just sit about and relax. The playground and playgym is for the little ones to ensure that boredom is a seldom heard word at Campialba.

Parking and Security

There is plenty of parking either side of the entry driveway at the front of the campsite.

There is also room for caravans (limited number of campsites).

A large wire fence around the perimeter of the grounds prevents "non-invited visitors" from coming and going. We also have a code-operated gate which keeps young people safe whilst onsite.

Things to bring

All campers in Cabins need to bring sleeping bags or blankets, sheets, pillows, towels, and personal toiletries

Also

Bibles, Testimonies - Musical Instruments, Music items and skits

Board games, Cards

Skateboards, RipStiks, roller blades, roller skates and protective gear including helmets

Fishing rods - Beach equipment - bucket shovel

Footballs, Cricket gear, Kite and Stuff for the oval etc.

Swimming gear, Hat and sunscreen
